


Standard National Roof Assembly Instructions



You will need:

A carpenters/joiners square.
A hammer (and punch if handy)
Exterior Wood Glue (we use polyurethane glue)
A flat surface on which to work



- 1. First do a dry assembly understanding where each part fits, which nails to use where, and solving any issues before gluing. If unsure then please call Nick on 07594 583151.
- 2. Apply glue to the lock joints on the roof sides and spread on all contact surfaces.
- 3. Assemble roof sides as glued.
- 4. Apply glue to the top of the roof sides and pin roof ply to the top of the sides. The roof top should serve as a square to ensure correct assembly but also check with a square.
- 5. Turn over and glue and nail the roof inner pieces into position ensuring that the ventilation holes coincide.
- 6. Leave for 24 hours on a flat surface for glue to set.
- 7. Place the galvanised cover on the roof and nail into place in the four corners. Then pin the cover into position ensuring a tight fit.
- 8. Tack into place the mesh squares that prevent wasps and robbing bees from entering.
