


## StandardOpen Mesh Floor Assembly Instructions



## You will need:

A carpenters/joiners square.
A tape measure
A hammer (and punch if handy)
Waterproof PVA woodglue
A flat surface on which to work

- 1. First do a dry assembly understanding where each part fits and solving any issues before gluing.
- 2. Generously apply glue to the tenons and spread on all contact surfaces.
- 3. Assemble and slide in the mesh floor immediately.
- 4. CHECK FOR SQUARE!! Two checks are better than one so use a square on the internal right angles and then to double check measure both diagonals (a) from one corner to the opposite corner and if they are within a mm or two then the item is square.
- 5. Leave the entrance block loose and do not glue into place. The entrance block is designed to be pushed into place without glue.
- 6. Leave for 24 hours for glue to set. If that means moving the piece then remember to check for square again.
