

Standard National Floor Assembly Instructions



You will need:

A carpenters/joiners square.
A hammer (and punch if handy)
Exterior Wood Glue (we use polyurethane glue)
A flat surface on which to work



- 1. First do a dry assembly understanding where each part fits and solving any issues before gluing. If in doubt then please call Nick on 07594 583151.
- 2. Apply sufficient glue into the grooves in the sides.
- 3. Push the tongued and grooved boards into place (apply glue to the tongues where the boards overlap). Make sure that at the front of the floor you have fitted a board with a flush face and that it is up to the front of the groove.
- 4. Once one side is fitted with boards line up the other side with the boards and push home.
- 5. Make sure that all boards are tight up to each other and fit snugly into the grooves.
- 6. Check for square. Modern glues are likely to provide a sufficient bond but if you prefer you can drive some 50mm pins through the outside of the side rails through into the floor boards.
- 7. Glue and pin the rear timber slat into place.
- 7. Leave for 24 hours on a flat surface for glue to set.
