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National Hive Stand Assembly Instructions

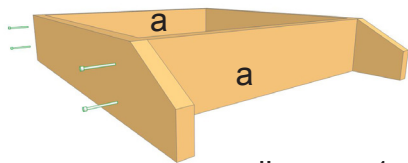

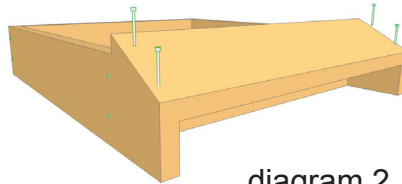

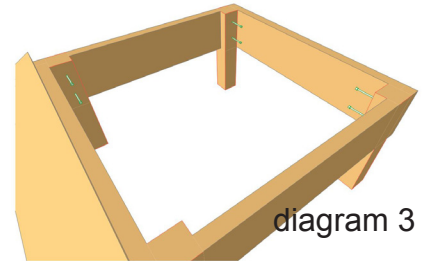

You will need:

A carpenters/joiners square.

A hammer

Exterior Wood Glue (we use polyurethane glue)

A flat surface on which to work



1. First do a dry assembly understanding where each part fits and solving any issues before gluing and nailing. If in doubt then please call Nick on 07594 583151.

2. Assemble the upper part of the stand as per diagram 1. Put glue into the rebates and nail through into the sides. It's best to do this with the stand sides on the bench and a square on the inner right angles ensuring you're working to square. Also be careful to ensure the cross pieces (labelled 'a') are sitting flush with the top and bottom of the sides.

3. Glue and nail the landing board into place as per diagram 2. The back edge (at the top) should be just in front of the front cross piece. Be careful to ensure that nailing doesn't push it out of position.

4. Glue and nail the legs onto the upper part of the stand as per diagram 3. Again this is best done with the sides placed flat on the bench so as to enable nailing. Be careful to ensure that nailing the legs into place doesn't undo your earlier work.

5. Before the glue goes off use your square to check everything is as it should be and also place the stand on a flat surface to see that the legs all sit firmly on the ground.

6. Well done. Have a brew and wait 24 hours for the glue to set.
